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Maspalomas Meloneras

You have decided to visit Maspalomas and Meloneras. Congratulations! Meloneras, which is the newly built part of Maspalomas, is an amazing vacation paradise in the south of Gran Canaria, 60 km from the capital Las Palmas and 35 km from the airport. Many new five star hotels are located here and the area is more exclusive than other alternatives on the island. It is marketed as a spa and wellness resort and you certainly find tranquility and relaxation. Although thousands of tourists are staying here all year round it is a very quiet and relaxing place. In addition, thanks to the wonderful boardwalk that stretches from the old lighthouse Faro de Maspalomas all the way to Meloneras beach, this resort is an excellent choice if you are into exercising like jogging or power walking.

Spending your holiday in Maspalomas/Meloneras is comfortable and easy, no matter which hotel you choose to stay in. You can always find taxi stands, cash machines, restaurants and good shopping within a very short

walking distance. You can easily take a bus and explore other parts of the island as well. Go for example to nearby Playa del Inglés or San Agustin (10 min) or visit the picturesque fishing village of Puerto de Mogán (40 min).

Located next to Meloneras beach, this holiday-package-deal delight offers their guests the whole shebang: big buffet restaurant, two outdoor pools, a spa, three bars and entertainment in the evening.

You know what you are getting nothing more, nothing less. The hotel in our view only qualifies for a four, not a five star rating.

Relaxing pool area with amazing ocean view. Rooms are nice and spacious. The hotel has a small gym (3€ for hotel guests), spa center + hairdresser.

Gastronomy: Snack bar at the pool, buffet restaurant and a la carte restaurant Gaudi.

Bars: Pool bar, lobby bar and nightclub/piano bar.

Lopesan Baobab Resort*****





The Lopesan hotel chain has three hotels in Meloneras (two 5-stars and one 4-star). Lopesan Baobab is the newest contribution and was built in 2009. It is in our view the most innovative and impressive when it comes to design. The architecture is overall inspired by the African continent and you will get amazed by the beautiful wooden ceilings, artistic furniture and colorful paintings. A huge pool area and plenty of entertainment for the kids make this hotel the perfect choice for the family.

Rooms are very nicely designed and have spacious balconies.

The hotel has a small gym, beauty center, massage and hairdresser.

Gastronomy: Buffet restaurant and two a la carte restaurants, Pili Pili and Akara, a

beautiful restaurant with a creative menu (try the spicy banana soup!).

Bars: Two pool bars and lobby bar.

Lopesan Costa Meloneras**** Resort, Spa & Casino



The hotel was built in 2000 and was the first Lopesan hotel in Meloneras. Despite being a four star hotel, Lopesan Costa Meloneras can definitely measure up to the big boys when it comes to service, exterior and evening entertainment. The hotel even has its own Casino.

The pool area is truly amazing with its small sandy beach and an enormous palm tree garden. (Perhaps too many palm trees – sometimes it's hard to find a sun bed that is not in the shadow). The quality of the rooms is 4-star level - clean, nice and spacious with good closet space and both a shower and a bathtub provided.

The hotel has a huge spa (3,500 square meters), including: Himalaya Salt Grotto, Hamam, Lava Flotation Pool, etc. You can get all types of beauty treatments and massages. In addition, the hotel has tennis courts, mini golf and gym.

Gastronomy: Two buffet restaurants and three a la carte restaurants – Ambassador, Vista Mar (Mediterranean menu), and Via Veneto with Italian cuisine and show-cooking. Bars: Four pool bars, terrace bar, lobby bar and nightclub. Internet: Wi-Fi.

Seaside Grand Hotel Residencia*****



With a nice location next to Maspalomas beach, this is the only hotel on Gran Canaria that is member of "The Leading Hotels of the World".

It is a small paradise that overwhelms with the amount of luxury that is showered on you upon arrival.

Parisian photographer and interior designer Alberto Pinto made this hotel look like a miniature Spanish village. Palm trees, the pool area with the small garden provide the kind of serenity you always wished for when on vacation.

The hotel has a small gym and beautiful spa facilities.

Gastronomy: Breakfast buffet and a la carte restaurant on the terrace (inside and outside seating), pool snack bar.

Rooms are nice but quite small. The pool area is very relaxing and next to it you have an outdoor gym and a wellness center with Thalassotherapy pool, saunas and relaxation area.

Gastronomy: Buffet restaurant and two a la carte restaurants - La Trattoria (Italian cuisine) and the more upscale Orangerie (Mediterranean).

Rooms are stylish and modernly designed. The hotel has several small pool areas. The best one is situated on the roof top with romantic sun beds and a flabbergasting view over the mountains as well as the Atlantic.

The hotel spa offers a variety of treatments and there is also a gym with different sports activities like Yoga and Aquaerobics.

Restaurant Mundo is not located in Maspalomas/Meloneras but we decided to include this restaurant since it is one of the better places in Gran Canaria. It is located smack in the middle of Playa del Inglés and it takes only 5 minutes to get there by taxi. Try their fantastic starters like grilled shrimps with mint dip or fish cakes. Our two absolute favorite main courses are the spaghetti with meatballs (in a spicy and really yummy tomato sauce) and the seared tuna with Thai noodles and sweet chili sauce.

Located on top of an insignificant looking building between Seaside Grand Hotel Residencia and Hotel Riu Palace (not far from the Maspalomas beach) it is unfortunately very easy to bypass this little gem. And that would be a huge mistake since it's one of the best restaurants in the area. (Tip: look for an enormous Shiva statue on top of the roof). Here you get high quality food, superb service, delivered in a wonderful setting. The food can best be described as Indian fusion: with creative mouth watering presentations (you will see what we mean when you come to the dessert). Prices are very reasonable.



Bandera Tapas y Copas

Bandera Tapas y Copas is located opposite the Casino in Meloneras. Nice and friendly atmosphere. Perfect place for a glass of wine or a relaxed dinner in the evening.

El Senador

Only a stone's throw from the seashore, on the left hand side of the light house, you find this nicely located bar/restaurant with live music. From the menu we can especially recommend the grilled salmon, Caesars' salad and Paella.

19th hole bar

Irish pub where you can enjoy a draft beer while listening to live music (rock) in the evening. Located on Boulevard El Faro, Maspalomas.

Activities

Maspalomas and Meloneras is the perfect place for relaxation. You have for example numerous cafes where you can sit and enjoy a drink or coffee under the sun.

Here you also have good shopping, especially when it comes to perfume and various beauty products.

If you are up for buying some clothes, you find everything from inexpensive Esprit and Mango to more fancy brands like Burberry, Michael Kors, Hugo Boss, Ralph Laurent and Calvin Klein. Other activities you can try are for example:



Puerto de Mogán

The "Venice of the Canaries", Puerto de Mogán, is a must to visit. It's an old fishing village with cobblestone alleys and small canals. Try any of the many restaurants next to the marina where you can have nice food while enjoying the ocean and boats cruising by.





Fataga

Visit the small mountain village of Fataga. Enjoy an amazing view while eating traditional Canary food like croquetas de jamón, queso frito and papas arrugadas with mojo sause in one of the restaurants. Here is also an arts shop and a small church.
